# Financial Toxicity Screening

## Documentation Flowsheet

The documentation of the Financial Toxicity Screening should be recorded into a Documentation Flowsheet so that the values can be recorded discretely and the score can be automatically calculated and store discretely.

The Documentation Flowsheet can then be presented in a Visit Navigator as a section that is easy to interact with.

## Best Practice Advisory

When the screening is calculated and saved, if the score exceeds the threshold established a pop-up BPA alert will fire to notify the staff that a referral to social work needs to be ordered.
